

**BY LAWS APPROVED AND ENACTED  
BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PIERCE-ARROW SOCIETY**

As of December 31, 2018

**BY LAW 1 - Delegation of Authority**

The Pierce-Arrow Society Board may on a case-by-case basis delegate specific authority to the PAS President. The President may then delegate some, or all, of such authority to other responsible individuals such as the head of a PAS Meet committee.

**BY LAW 2 - Treasurer**

One person shall not hold the Office of Treasurer of both the Pierce-Arrow Society and also the Office of Treasurer of the Pierce-Arrow Foundation concurrently.

**BY LAW 3 – Klausmeyer Award** – The Otto Klausmeyer Distinguished Service Award was established in 1987 to honor members of the Society who have served the Society in an outstanding manner deserving of special recognition. Initially the Klausmeyer Award Selection Committee consisted of the last three award recipients. In June 2012 the Klausmeyer Award Selection Committee was increased from three to five members by adding the sitting President and the current Chair of Nominating Committee, the latter being the Chair of the Klausmeyer Award Selection Committee. Any member may nominate another member for this award by submitting a written justification to the Chair of the Klausmeyer Award Selection Committee. The deliberations of this select committee are to be confidential and the Chair of the Klausmeyer Award Selection Committee shall prepare a written justification based on such deliberations. The President will present this award at the annual banquet.

**BY LAW 4 – Vehicle Estimates and Appraisals** –No Director shall use his/her position in the Pierce-Arrow Society as establishing a knowledge base to offer an opinion on the authenticity of specific Pierce-Arrow vehicles or on the possible sale values of such vehicle. However, this is not intended to restrict any director offering an opinion as a private individual based on his/her own personal knowledge.

**BY LAW 5 – Vehicle Assistance Policy** – This policy applies to all Pierce-Arrow Society (PAS) Annual, Winter, and Region Meets and Tours.

Vehicle Assistance: The PAS strongly encourages Meet Committees and Regions to support vehicle driving activities by providing a service vehicle which shall be equipped at a minimum with fuel, oil, water for radiators, a 6-volt battery and jumper cables. A floor jack and jack stands may also be useful for members who encounter trouble.

Vehicle Hauling and Towing: The PAS and PAS Regions shall not engage in hauling or towing disabled vehicles due to liability concerns if a vehicle were to be damaged during such an activity.

**BY LAW 6 – Notice of Tour Completion Requirement for Judging in Annual Meet Registration**

Annual Meet Committees shall include in their registration forms a statement of the requirement that any vehicle to be judged must complete at least one day's tour at the Meet or make special arrangements with the Chief Judge.

**BY LAW 7 – Regions Self-Supporting Except for New-Member Subsidy**

Regions should be self-supporting via dues and activity fees. The only standing PAS subsidy to Regions is \$10 toward the first year's Region dues of a "new member." This subsidy is not automatic: a Region must apply to or invoice the PAS Treasurer (email is sufficient) to receive these funds. A "new member" is defined as a member of the PAS, either paid or complimentary, in his/her "home" Region, who has not previously been a member of that Region.

The subsidy to Regions issue will be re-evaluated annually at the Winter Board meeting based on the Society's finances, and the results announced to Regions.

At annual meets, a Tour Book containing routes shall be issued to each registered member family, and additional Tour Book(s) shall be issued for each additional Pierce-Arrow motorized vehicle when a member has registered more than one such vehicle.
