Edward William Pierce, age 79 years, of Neshanic Station, NJ, passed away on Saturday, July 13, 2019. Ed is survived by his wife of forty-seven years, Virginia Ochs Pierce; sister and brother-in-law, Maryann and Dave Coombs; sisters-in- law and brothers-in-law, Marilyn and Ron DeFulvio and Nancy Ochs and Bud Wissner and numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins. Ed enrolled in Colorado State University, Fort Collins, CO, earning a B.S. in Business Agriculture in 1964 and was involved in various aspects of agriculture throughout his life. He was a member of the Somerset County Board of Agriculture, the New Jersey Farm Bureau, the American Simmental Association and the Fullblood Simmental Fleckvieh Federation. A longtime member of the Pierce-Arrow Society, he and his wife went to Buffalo, NY in 2001 to celebrate 100 years since the first Pierce-Arrow automobile was made. Ed's great-grandfather, George Norman Pierce, had driven the first Pierce-Arrow at the World's Fair in 1901. Interestingly, the Pierce-Arrow was the first official presidential automobile beginning in 1909, continuing through the 1920's. The Society extends its sincerest condolences on behalf of its members to the Pierce family.







NOTE: For anyone interested, you do not have to hunt for an additional split rim. Coker Tire will make a split rim for you. I had them do it and sent them a dimensional drawing of the rim, including the placement of the tube stem hole and where the split should be relative to the tube stem hole. They offered a closure snap, but I had them skip that for me and had a local blacksmith create a Series 80 style closure (easy to do). The rim is identical to the original and has run on the car without a problem for the past 5 years.
