

the trainers, the jockeys and in particular the beautiful horses that comprise the Saratoga National Hall of Fame. A definite don't miss!



In front of important military battles, the Quakers referred to this town as Fort William Henry and Revolutionary wars. The town was founded by Quaker founder, Abraham Johannes Glen in 1788,

Amazingly, Glens Falls has been destroyed by fire at least five times in its history: twice during the American Revolution and again in 1864, 1884, and 1902. Luckily, the buildings standing today are incredibly preserved, giving the modern city a uniquely historic charm.
