

Our first stop on the Saturday tour was at the Templar factory building. Templars were assembled in Cleveland from 1918 to 1925 and we saw on display what is the largest collection of Templars (10) owned by Dave Buehler.

Templar was unique because of its association with the Masonic Temple. All of the officers in the company were Masons and there were Masonic symbols built into the cars.



Continuing around the west side of Cleveland we drove by two Winton plants, Leon Rubay's custom body factory and the Baker Electric Car factory.





Following the ship tour we motored through the east side of Cleveland and arrived at the Crawford Auto-Aviation Museum at the Western Reserve Historical Society. There we saw a fascinating collection of cars manufactured in Cleveland including Peerless, Jordan, White, Baker Electric, Rauch & Lang Electric, Templar, Winton, Stearns-Knight, Chandler, Royal Tourist and Rubay. In total there were 80 different trucks or cars manufactured in Cleveland. Many of these were in the early infancy of the automobile before Detroit became the center of the US automotive world.



On our drive back to the motel we passed the Fred P. Brand Motor Co. building which has the Pierce-Arrow logo built into the building walls!
