With smooth, well-maintained roads that are perfect for our Pierce-Arrows, this tour is a smooth ride from start to finish.

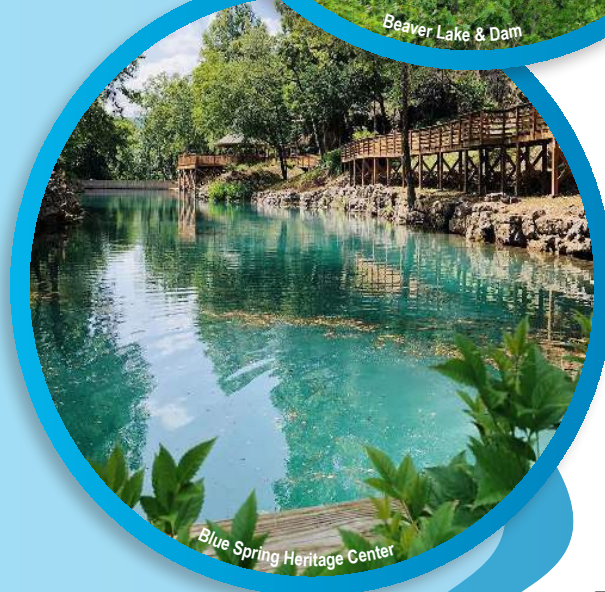
Whether you're a history buff, nature lover, or just a fan of great drives, the **Pig Trail** will not disappoint.

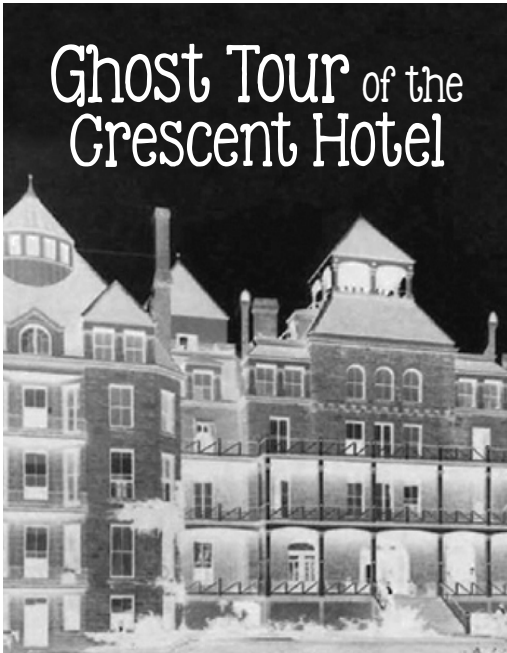

## Ghost Tour of the Crescent Hotel - Thursday
